Brief about Event

Saurashtra University in collaboration with SU Startup and Entrepreneurship Council and IIC Saurashtra University, were celebrated 78th Independence Day.

BJP National President Jagat Prakash Nadda launched the nationwide "Tiranga Yatra" from Rajkot, Gujarat. He flagged off the yatra and participated in it. Prior to the event, he paid tribute to Mahatma Gandhi's statue and honored Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel for his contributions to national unity. The "Har Ghar Tiranga" campaign, which encouraged citizens to hoist the national flag at their homes, continued until August 15 to foster unity and patriotism.

The event was attended by Gujarat Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel, State BJP President C.R. Patil, former CM Vijay Rupani, and other leaders. Key events were planned in four major cities in Gujarat: Rajkot, Ahmedabad, Surat, and Vadodara. This year's "Tiranga Yatra" was organized on 10 August 2024, Saturday. The yatra followed pre-arranged routes, with a large number of students from all the colleges of Rajkot city participating. NSS volunteers from the colleges also joined the yatra. At 8:30 AM on 10-08-2024, students from all colleges of Rajkot gathered in large numbers near the statue of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel on Racecourse Ring Road, Rajkot. Students, along with administrative and academic staff members of Saurashtra University, also participated.

The 78th Independence Day was celebrated with enthusiasm at Saurashtra University on August 15, 2024. The national flag was hoisted by Honorable Chancellor Dr. Kamal Sinh Dodiya, who extended his best wishes for Independence Day to everyone. Following the flag hoisting, Chancellor Dr. Kamal Sinh Dodiya and Registrar Dr. Ramesh G. Parmar paid tribute by laying flowers at the statues of prominent figures such as Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, Swami Vivekananda, Saraswati Devi, and the university's first Vice-Chancellor, Shri Dolarray Mankad. The event saw participation from university leaders, faculty, staff, students, including NCC cadets and NSS volunteers.
