SU Startup and Entrepreneurship Council and IIC Saurashtra University in partnership with Noble University, Junagadh, was hosted a session titled "How to innovate and get funded".

During the event, speaker Mr. Parth Sejpal provided a brief overview of SUSEC and encouraged students to bring innovative concepts. After that sir give information about important things related to coming up with new ideas and starting businesses. He discussed understanding innovation, having creative ideas, solving problems, and the activities of SSIP and IIC. He added that how these programs help students and teachers become more innovative and entrepreneurial. These programs aimed to help make India better by supporting new and creative businesses and encouraging people to have an entrepreneurial mindset. The talk on "Innovation and Startup" was a great opportunity for people to talk and learn about starting businesses and being innovative. It inspired future business owners and created a good environment for new businesses.
