#### **Brief about Event**

Department of Chemistry, in collaboration with the SU Startup and Entrepreneurship Council and IIC Saurashtra University, was organized a sensitization program on "Idea to Impact".

During the event, speaker Mr. Parth Sejpal provided a brief overview of SUSEC and encouraged students to bring innovative concepts. He informed students on the difference between innovation and creativity. Creativity is about generating ideas, while innovation is about applying those ideas to create something valuable. Creativity is the spark, while innovation is the fire that turns the spark into something that can light up the world that was understood by the speaker.

Sir explained that innovation entails modifying existing products or processes, highlighting various examples to clarify this concept. In contrast, invention involves the creation of entirely new products, processes, devices, methods, or concepts. The main goal of the event was to help students understand about startups, innovation, inventions, and the various government programs that help startups.

Also, talked about innovation during the event that emphasizing how important it is to bring new ideas to solve problems. He also talked about how we should recognize existing things and understand the different kinds of innovations. This helped students learn more about the topic. Sir explained that after the Minimum Viable Product (MVP) is ready, the next step is to conduct user trials. It's essential to gather honest feedback from potential users, including strangers, to understand how they interact with the product and what improvements or adjustments are necessary. This feedback will help validate assumptions and identify areas for enhancement.

After that sir give information about important things related to coming up with new ideas and starting businesses. He discussed understanding innovation, having creative ideas, solving problems, and the activities of SSIP and IIC. He added that how these programs help students and teachers become more innovative and entrepreneurial. These programs aimed to help make India better by supporting new and creative businesses and encouraging people to have an entrepreneurial mindset. The talk on "Idea to Impact" was a great opportunity for people to talk and learn about starting businesses and being innovative. It inspired future business owners and created a good environment for new businesses. Overall, it was a very informative and interesting session that helped people understand how important innovation is for making the economy grow and society improve.

#### Outcome


