Brief about Event

The SU Startup and Entrepreneurship Council, in collaboration with IIC Saurashtra University and the Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, successfully organized National Startup Week from $16^{\rm th}$ January to $21^{\rm st}$ January 2025 at the Seminar Hall, Department of Pharmacy, Saurashtra University. The event aimed to foster entrepreneurship and startup culture among students, faculties, and aspiring entrepreneurs.

Day 1: 16th January 2025 – Entrepreneurship and Startup Speaker: Shri. Prakash Gohel (Senior Officer, CED, Rajkot)

- This session introduced participants to the fundamentals of entrepreneurship, covering key aspects such as identifying business opportunities, startup ideation, and market validation.
- Shri. Gohel emphasized the importance of innovation and risk management in building a successful startup.

Day 5: 21st January 2025 – Government Grants and Startup Support Speaker: Mr. Parth Sejpal (IPR Chair Professor – SPRIHA, Saurashtra University)

- Mr. Sejpal provided a detailed overview of startup policies, eligibility criteria, and application processes for funding opportunities.
- Attendees gained insights into intellectual property protection, legal frameworks, and tax benefits for startups.
